

Reading Prompts

Goal	Suggested Prompts
Concepts of Print	 Where do we start reading? Where do I go next? Point to each word as you read. Can you make it match? How many letters are in the word? Show me one letter. Show me two.
Using Letters	 Can you name a letter on this page? I see a letter(s) that makes the sound(s). Can you find it? How do we start this word? What is the first sound?
Self-Monitoring	 You stopped reading. What did you notice? Something was tricky. Can you find it? Are you right? Did that look right? Run your finger under the word as you say the sounds. Reread and check the beginning (middle, end) of the word.
Decoding	 What can you do to help yourself? Something wasn't quite right. Try that again and look carefully. Stretch the sounds and then blend them together to read the word. Do you know a word like that? Look for a part you know. Make the first sounds. Now say more. Can you break the word into parts? Show yourself the first part (last part). Try a different vowel sound.
Comprehension	 What do you think will happen next? Have you ever felt like the character? How did the character's feelings change? Why? What happened in the story? What was the problem in the story? What did you learn? What do you think the author's message is? How did the illustrations help you understand the story?
Vocabulary	 What does this word mean? How did you figure it out? Reread and think about the story. Use the glossary. How did the illustrations help you understand the meaning of that word?
Fluency	 Can you read it more quickly? How do you sound? Reread that and sound like the character. Can you make it sound interesting?
